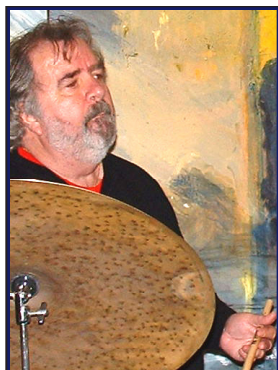
Dean Rader

Dean Rader's *Works & Days*, won the 2010 T. S. Eliot Poetry Prize. His poem "Twilight at Ocean Beach: 14" was named one of the best poems of 2010 by Verse Daily. He writes for The San Francisco Chronicle and The Huffington Post. A professor at the University of San Francisco, he won USF's 2011 Distinguished Research Award.

Judy Halebsky's poetry collection, *Sky=Empty*, won the New Issues Prize and was a finalist for the California Book Award. The MacDowell Colony, the Millay Colony, and the Japanese Ministry of Culture have supported her work. Originally from Nova Scotia, she now lives in San Francisco and teaches at Dominican University of California.
